- YTD expenses are unusually low due to an invoicing issue with Valley Landscaping as well as the staggering of services like mulching and cycle maintenance.

**CARB** Reported by Stephanie Polackwich

• Only 2 CARB apps are outstanding as they had just been received. One is for roofing and one is for landscaping. No issues foreseen.

#### Maintenance Committee Reported by Mark Watlock

- The maintenance cycle has begun.
- Power washing to start May 13. Painting and trim work will continue into the summer.
- Noticed that there is mold on the light posts. Will see if these posts can be power washed when other power washing takes place.
- Mail carrier lets Mark know if a box needs repairing/replacement.
- There are several mailboxes with issues with rivets, rust, flag problems. Mark was
  wondering if we should see if we could hire a handyman to repair, but it was thought
  that it would be too costly to hire one. One resident indicated she had fixed her mailbox
  and could help others if needed.

#### Landscape Committee Reported by Stephanie Polackwich

- Valley sprayed horticultural oil and barberry oil in April and put granular fertilizer in berms.
- There was a turf treatment in March and in April.

- Mulching was supposed to start on 4/8 but did not. Hoping it will start this Friday in to the following week for berm and foundations.
- Trimming of foundation bed and common area berm shrubs to begin in July.
- Waiting for estimate to remove rest of purple plums.
- Will Allen of Plant Rx fertilized and inspected our young trees this spring and will be fertilizing and treating the pin oaks this month into June.

#### Newsletter/Website Reported by Teri Smith

- Updated Directory and Newsletter went out in March. Next one will go out in June.
- 3 houses turning over. Two for sale other will be a rental.
